

## ~APPEARING (62)

[English, coming into view or sight, becoming visible, emerging, coming out, showing, materializing, Opposite of, **disappearing**]

- If a leprous man had a scab **appearing** on the skin after his being seen by the priest then he must appear a second time.
- But if the scab has unquestionably spread in the skin after his **appearing** before the priest for the establishment of his purification, he must then appear the second time before the priest. (**Leviticus 13:7**)
- Yehowah's angel **appeared** to Manoah and his wife once.
- And Yehowah's angel did not repeat **appearing** to Manoah and his wife anymore. Then it was that Manoah knew that he had been Yehowah's angel. (**Judges 13:21**)
- Samuel was afraid to tell High Priest Eli of Yehowah's **appearing** to him.
- And Samuel continued lying down until the morning. Then he opened the doors of Yehowah's house. And Samuel was afraid to tell Eli of the **appearing**. (**1 Samuel 3:15**)
- Yehowah became incensed at Solomon for his falling away from hi to worship false gods even after his **appearing** to him twice.
- And Yehowah came to be incensed at Solomon, because his heart had inclined away from Yehowah the God of Israel, the one **appearing** to him twice. (**1 Kings 11:9**)
- Ezekiel saw something like the **appearance** of a sapphire stone in the likeness of a throne **appearing** above them.
- And I continued to see, and, look! Upon the expanse that was over the head of the cherubs there was something like sapphire stone, like the **appearance** of the likeness of a throne, **appearing** above them. (**Ezekiel 10:1**)
- Daniel was blessed with another **appearing** of a vision after the first one's he had seen.

- In the third year of the kingship of Belshazzar the king, there was a vision that **appeared** to me, even me, Daniel, after the one **appearing** to me at the start. (**Daniel 8:1**)
- Herod tried to carefully ascertain the time of the stars **appearing**.
- Then Herod secretly summoned the astrologers and carefully ascertained from them the time of the stars **appearing**. (**Matthew 2:7**)
- James told fellow Christians that their life was a mist **appearing** for but a moment.
- Whereas you do not know what your life will be tomorrow. For you are a mist **appearing** for a little while and then disappearing. (**James 4:14**)
