

~APPEARS (50)

[English, comes into view or sight, becomes visible, emerges, comes out, shows, materializes, Opposite of, **disappears**]

- On the day that the living flesh **appears** in a leprous person from then on he is unclean. If leprosy appears in the garment then it must be burned.
- But on the day the living flesh **appears** in it, he will be unclean. (**Leviticus 13:14**)
- However, if it still **appears** in the garment or in the warp or in the woof or in any article of skin, it is breaking out. You should burn in the fire whatever it is in which the plague is. (**Leviticus 13:57**)
- Samuel was told by Yehowah that the way a man **appears** to him was not the same way that Yehowah sees him. Yehowah sees the heart.
- But Yehowah said to Samuel; Do not look at his appearance and at the height of his stature, for I have rejected him. For not the way man sees is the way God sees, because mere man sees what **appears** to the eyes, but as for Yehowah, he sees what the heart is. (**1 Samuel 16:7**)
- The Psalmist expressed how faithful one's among his people would walk and be refreshed by the yearly festivals **appearing** in Zion before their God.
- They will walk on from vital energy to vital energy, each one **appears** to God in Zion. (**Psalms 84:7**)
- When Christ appears, who will be the one **standing approved**, for he will come like the fire of a refiner and the lye of laundrymen.
- But who will be putting up with the day of his coming, and who will be the one standing when he **appears**? For he will be like the fire of a refiner and like the lye of laundrymen. (**Malachi 3:2**)
- The second **appearance** of Christ will be apart from sin, and toward those who are earnestly looking for him.

- So also the Christ was offered once for all time to bear the sins of many. And the second time that he **appears** it will be apart from sin, and to those earnestly looking for him for their salvation. (**Hebrews 9:28**)
