- Yehowah **applied** the same measuring line to Judah that he had earlier **applied** to Israel.
- And I shall certainly stretch upon Jerusalem the measuring line **applied** to Samaria and also the leveling instrument applied to the house of Ahab, and I shall simply wipe Jerusalem clean just as one wipes the handleless bowl clean, wiping it clean and turning it upside down. (2 Kings 21:13)
- When David brought the copper altar and the tent of meeting to Jerusalem the congregation **applied** their worship toward it.
- And the copper altar that Bezalel the son of Uri the son of Hur had made had been put before the tabernacle of Yehowah, and Solomon and the congregation **applied** as usual to it. (2 Chronicles 1:5)
- The doers of the repair work toward Yehowah's temple **applied** the funds contributed to the work of repairing the temple.
- Then they put it into the hand of the doers of the work that were appointed over the house of Yehowah. In turn the doers of the work who were active in the house of Yehowah **applied** it to mending and repairing the house. (2 Chronicles 34:10)
- Solomon **applied** his heart to know wisdom and to understand the occupation of the sons of mankind.
- In accord with this I **applied** my heart to know wisdom and to see the occupation that is carried on in the earth, because there is one seeing no sleep with his eyes, either by day or by night. (Ecclesiastes 8:16)
- The makers of idols do not know and have not **applied** understanding to what they do. Yehowah is the true God.
- Do you people not know? Do you not hear? Has it not been told to you from the outset? Have you not **applied** understanding from the foundations of the earth? (Isaiah 40:21)

- Herod **applied** his power to mistreating some of the Christian congregation.
- About that particular time Herod the king **applied** his hands to mistreating some of those of the congregation. (**Acts of Apostles 12:1**)
- A multitude of the Jews came up from Jerusalem and **applied** to Agrippa to have Paul turned over to them.
- And Festus said; King Agrippa and all you men who are present with us, you are beholding this man concerning whom all the multitude of the Jews together have **applied** to me both in Jerusalem and here, shouting that he ought not to live any longer. (**Acts of Apostles 25:24**)
