

~APPOINTMENT (95)

[English, meeting, date, scheduled time, engagement, rendezvous, prior arrangement, slot, selection]

- Two trumpets were made to call the assembly to come to the tent of meeting to keep their **appointment** there with Yehowah.
- And they must blow on them both, and the whole assembly must keep their **appointment** with you at the entrance of the tent of meeting. (**Numbers 10:3**)
- And if they should blow on just one, the chieftains as heads of the thousands of Israel must also keep their **appointment** with you. (**Numbers 10:4**)
- The Canaanite nations joined together against Yehowah's people to try to defeat them and met by **appointment** at the waters of Merom.
- Then all these kings met together by **appointment** and came and encamped together at the waters of Merom to fight against Israel. (**Joshua 11:5**)
- David had made an **appointment** with his young men for such and such a place to meet.
- At this David said to Ahimelech the priest: The king himself commanded me as to a matter, and he went on to say to me, Let no one know anything at all of the matter concerning which I am sending you and concerning which I have commanded you. And I have made an **appointment** with the young men for such and such a place. (**1 Samuel 21:2**)
- Keeping the festivals before Yehowah was an **appointment** that all the nation honored in Solomon's day
- And King Solomon and with him all the assembly of Israel, those keeping their **appointment** with him, were before the Ark, sacrificing sheep and cattle that could not be counted or numbered for multitude. (**1 Kings 8:5**)
- And King Solomon and all the assembly of Israelites that were keeping their **appointment** with him before the Ark were

sacrificing sheep and cattle that could not be counted or numbered for multitude. (**2 Chronicles 5:6**)

- **Nehemiah turned down an **appointment** to meet with Sanballat and Geshem who were scheming to do him harm.**
- **Sanballat and Geshem immediately sent to me, saying; Do come, and let us meet together by **appointment** in the villages of the valley plain of Ono. But they were scheming to do me harm. (**Nehemiah 6:2**)**
- **Shemiah met by **appointment** in the temple to escape a plot on his life.**
- **And I myself entered the house of Shemaiah the son of Delaiah the son of Mehetabel while he was shut up. And he proceeded to say; Let us meet by **appointment** at the house of the true God, within the temple, and let us close the doors of the temple, for they are coming in to kill you, even by night they are coming in to kill you. (**Nehemiah 6:10**)**
- **Job's three troublesome comforters met together by **appointment** to **comfort** Job.**
- **And three companions of Job got to hear of all this calamity that had come upon him, and they proceeded to come, each one from his own place, Eliphaz the Temanite and Bildad the Shuhite and Zophar the Naamathite. So they met together by **appointment** to come and sympathize with him and comfort him. (**Job 2:11**)**
- **Elihu spoke of God having an **appointment** to make it rain in the heavens**
- **Do you know when God laid an **appointment** upon them, and when he caused the light of his cloud to beam? (**Job 37:15**)**
- **Kings will meet together by **appointment** when Zion comes to birth.**
- **For, look! The kings themselves have met by **appointment**, they have passed by together. (**Psalms 48:4**)**

- Amos asks, Will two meet unless by **appointment**, referring to Yehowah's prophetic word being our **appointment** to draw close to our God and do his will.
- Will two walk together unless they have met by **appointment**?
