## ~APPORTIONED (113)

[English, shared out, allocated, allotted, assigned, dished out, divided up, distributed, doled out]

- Lands were to be apportioned by the number of the peoples.
- To these the land should be apportioned for an inheritance by the number of the names. (Numbers 26:53)
- Only by the lot should the land be apportioned. According to the names of the tribes of their fathers they should get an inheritance. (Numbers 26:55)
- But there were still left among the sons of Israel those whose inheritance they had not apportioned out, namely, seven tribes. (Joshua 18:2)
- Yehowah. Thus Joshua there apportioned the land to the sons of Israel in their shares. (Joshua 18:10)
- By the determination of the lot one's inheritance should be apportioned between the many and the few. (Numbers 26:56)
- Moses warned the Israelites not to worship the army of the heavens. For such things were not apportioned to his people.
- And that you may not raise your eyes to the heavens and indeed see the sun and the moon and the stars, all the army of the heavens, and actually get seduced and bow down to them and serve them, which Yehowah your God has apportioned to all the peoples under the whole heavens. (Deuteronomy 4:19)
- And they proceeded to go and serve other gods and to bow down to them, gods that they had not known and he had not apportioned to them. (Deuteronomy 29:26)
- David apportioned to each man and woman a portion of food for their journey home.
- Further, he apportioned to all the people, to the whole crowd of Israel, man as well as woman, to each one a ring-shaped cake of

- bread and a date cake and a raisin cake, after which all the people went each to his own house. (2 Samuel 6:19)
- Further, he apportioned to all the Israelites, man as well as woman, to each one a round loaf of bread and a date cake and a raisin cake. (1 Chronicles 16:3)
- Yehowah himself cast the line and apportioned the lot for the sons of Israel to dwell.
- And it is He that has cast for them the lot, and his own hand has apportioned the place to them by the measuring line. To time indefinite they will take possession of it, for generation after generation they will reside in it. (Isaiah 34:17)
- Yehowah swore that he would call nations to account who had displaced his people from the land he had apportioned to them.
- I will also collect together all the nations and bring them down to the low plain of Jehoshaphat, and I will put myself on judgment with them there on account of my people and my inheritance Israel, whom they scattered among the nations, and they apportioned out my own land. (Joel 3:2)
- Yehowah foretold the exile of Israel, showing, that others would apportion by a measuring rope, the ground that formerly belonged to them.
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; As regards your wife, in the city she will become a prostitute. And as regards your sons and your daughters, by the sword they will fall. And as regards your ground, by the measuring rope it will be apportioned out. And as regards you yourself, on unclean ground you will die, and as regards Israel, it will without fail go into exile from its own ground. (Amos 7:17)
- Yehowah foretold a day when all the nations would come against Jerusalem, and then take her and apportion her as spoil from her conquest.
- Look! There is a day coming, belonging to Yehowah, and the spoil of you will certainly be apportioned out in the midst of you. (Zechariah 14:1)

- Soldiers as prophesied apportioned by lot Jesus clothing.
- Therefore they said to one another; Let us not tear it, but let us determine by lots over it whose it will be. This was that the scripture might be fulfilled; They apportioned my outer garments among themselves, and upon my apparel they cast lots. And so the soldiers really did these things. (John 19:24)
- Paul showed that his fine work as an Apostle was a cause for boasting, but not outside of his assigned work.
- For our part we will boast, not outside our assigned boundaries, but according to the boundary of the territory that God apportioned to us by measure, making it reach even as far as you. (2 Corinthians 10:13)
- Abraham apportioned a tenth of everything to Melchizedek from the spoils of war.
- And to whom Abraham apportioned a tenth from all things, is first of all, by translation, King of Righteousness, and is then also king of Salem, that is, King of Peace. (Hebrews 7:2)
