- Men who do not **approve** of holding God in accurate knowledge like idol worshipers God also has given up to a **disapproved** mental state.
- And just as they did not **approve** of holding God in accurate knowledge, God gave them up to a **disapproved** mental state, to do the things not fitting. (**Romans 1:28**)
- Christians know God's will and **approve** of things that are excellent.
- And you know his will and **approve** of things that are excellent because you are orally instructed out of the Law. (**Romans 2:18**)
- A man must **approve** himself as being fitly united with God through his spirit, before partaking of the emblems at the Memorial.
- First let a man **approve** himself after scrutiny, and thus let him eat of the loaf and drink of the cup. (**1 Corinthians 11:28**)
- Paul requested the men of Corinth to send by letters men they **approved** of to take this kind gift to Jerusalem.
- But when I get there, whatever men you **approve** of by letters, these I shall send to carry your kind gift to Jerusalem. (**1 Corinthians 16:3**)
- Paul showed that God did not **approve** of animal offerings, but that he prepared a body for his Messiah appropriate to take away the sins of the world.
- You did not **approve** of whole burnt offerings and sin offering. (**Hebrews 10:6**)
- After first saying; You did not want nor did you **approve** of sacrifices and offerings and whole burnt offerings and sin offering, sacrifices that are offered according to the Law.
