- The prefix arch, meaning chief or principal, implies that there is only one archangel, the chief angel, in the Scriptures, archangel is never found in the plural.

- In speaking of the preeminence of the archangel and the authority of his office, does so in reference to the resurrected Lord Jesus Christ:

- It is, therefore, not without significance that the only name directly associated with the word archangel is Michael.
