

~ARGUING (34)

[English, in conflict, at variance, in disagreement, in dispute, quarreling, disagreeing, in opposition, in contention]

- Job stated that he would enjoy **arguing** with God more than he enjoyed **arguing** with the three troublesome comforters.
- However, I, for my part, would speak to the Almighty himself, and in **arguing** with God I would find delight. (**Job 13:3**)
- Jesus disciples were **arguing** with one another because of not having any loaves, but Jesus had asked them about the leaven of the loaves.
- So they went **arguing** with one another over the fact that they had no loaves. (**Mark 8:16**)
- When Jesus questioned his disciples they were reluctant to tell him what they were **arguing** about for they **argued** over who was greatest among them.
- And they came into Capernaum. Now when he was inside the house he put the question to them; What were you **arguing** over on the road? (**Mark 9:33**)
- Paul argued that he was guilty of nothing for when found in the temple he was not even **arguing** with anyone.
- And they found me neither in the temple **arguing** with anyone nor causing a mob to rush together, either in the synagogues or throughout the city. (**Acts of Apostles 24:12**)
