

## ~AROUSE (58)

[English, stimulate, awaken, provoke, produce, stir, stir up, rouse,  
Opposite of, dampen]

- The Psalmist called Yehowah to **arouse** to judgment in his behalf.
- Do **arouse** yourself and awake to my judgment, O my God, even Yehowah, to my case at Law. (**Psalms 35:23**)
- Do **arouse** yourself. Why do you keep sleeping, O Yehowah? Do awake. Do not keep casting off forever. (**Psalms 44:23**)
- The Shulamite told the daughters of Jerusalem not to **arouse** love in her till it feels inclined.
- I have put you under oath, O daughters of Jerusalem, by the female gazelles or by the hinds of the field, that you try not to awaken or **arouse** love in me until it feels inclined. (**Song of Solomon 2:7**)
- I have put you under oath, O daughters of Jerusalem, by the female gazelles or by the hinds of the field, that you try not to awaken or **arouse** love in me until it feels inclined. (**Song of Solomon 3:5**)
- I have put you under oath, O daughters of Jerusalem, that you try not to awaken or **arouse** love in me until it feels inclined. (**Song of Solomon 8:4**)
- At the ascent to Luhith a cry was **aroused** over the catastrophe to Moab.
- My own heart cries out over Moab himself. The runaways thereof are as far along as Zoar and Eglath-shelishiyah. For on the ascent of Luhith, with weeping each one goes up on it, for on the way to Horonaim they **arouse** the outcry about the catastrophe. (**Isaiah 15:5**)
- The king of the North was spoken of in Daniel of **arousing** his power and his heart against the king of the South.
- And he will **arouse** his power and his heart against the king of the

south with a great military force, and the king of the south, for his part, will excite himself for the war with an exceedingly great and mighty military force. And he will not stand, because they will scheme out against him schemes. (**Daniel 11:25**)

- **Joel speaks of a time of war when the powerful men are aroused to war.**
- **Proclaim this, you people, among the nations; Sanctify war! Arouse the powerful men! Let them draw near! Let them come up, all the men of war! (Joel 3:9)**
