

## ~AROUSING (41)

[English, moving, touching, poignant, affecting, exciting, disturbing]

- The wicked are like a detested image that upon one's **arousing** from sleep is despised.
- Like a dream after awaking, O Yehowah, so when **arousing** yourself you will despise their very image. (**Psalms 73:20**)
- Yehowah **aroused** the Medes and the Persians against Babylon to bring her down to the earth.
- Here I am **arousing** against them the Medes, who account silver itself as nothing and who, as respects gold, take no delight in it. (**Isaiah 13:17**)
- For here I am **arousing** and bringing up against Babylon a congregation of great nations from the land of the north, and they will certainly array themselves against her. From there she will be captured. one's arrows are like those of a mighty man causing bereavement of children, who does not come back without results. (**Jeremiah 50:9**)
- When Jews were sold in slavery to Greeks Yehowah promised to **arouse** them to return and pay back their treatment to those selling them as slaves.
- Here I am **arousing** them to come from the place where you have sold them, and I will pay back your treatment upon your own heads. (**Joel 3:7**)
- Paul used his letters to **arouse** his brothers clear thinking facilities through constant reminders.
- Beloved ones, this is now the second letter I am writing you, in which, as in my first one, I am **arousing** your clear thinking faculties by way of a reminder. (**2 Peter 3:1**)
