## ~ARPACHSHAD (80) (Ar-pach'shad)

- A son of Shem. He was born two years after the Flood, that is, about 2368 B.C.E, and died 438 years later. He was an ancestor of the Hebrews through his grandson Eber.
- The sons of Shem were Elam and Asshur and Arpachshad and Lud and Aram. (Genesis 10:22)
- And Arpachshad became father to Shelah, and Shelah became father to Eber. (Genesis 10:24)
- This is the history of Shem. Shem was a hundred years old when he became father to Arpachshad two years after the deluge. (Genesis 11:10)
- And after his fathering Arpachshad Shem continued to live five hundred years. Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters. (Genesis 11:11)
- And Arpachshad lived thirty-five years. Then he became father to Shelah. (Genesis 11:12)
- And after his fathering Shelah Arpachshad continued to live four hundred and three years. Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters. (Genesis 11:13)
- The sons of Shem were Elam and Asshur and Arpachshad and Lud and Aram, and Uz and Hul and Gether and Mash. (1 Chronicles 1:17)
- As for Arpachshad, he became father to Shelah, and Shelah himself became father to Eber. (1 Chronicles 1:18)
- And to Eber two sons were born. The name of the one was Peleg, because in his days the earth was divided, and the name of his brother was Joktan. (1 Chronicles 1:19)
- As for Joktan, he became father to Almodad and Sheleph and Hazarmaveth and Jerah (1 Chronicles 1:20)

- And Hadoram and Uzal and Diklah (1 Chronicles 1:21)
- And Obal and Abimael and Sheba (1 Chronicles 1:22)
- And Ophir and Havilah and Jobab, all these were the sons of Joktan. (1 Chronicles 1:23)
- Shem, Arpachshad, Shelah. (1 Chronicles 1:24)
- Eber, Peleg, Reu. (1 Chronicles 1:25)
- Serug, Nahor, Terah. (1 Chronicles 1:26)
- Abram, that is to say, Abraham. (1 Chronicles 1:27)
- He is shown to be the father of Shelah, although Luke's account;
- Son of Serug, son of Reu, son of Peleg, son of Eber, son of Shelah. (Luke 3:35)
- Son of Cainan, son of Arpachshad, son of Shem, son of Noah, son of Lamech. (Luke 3:36)
- By the inclusion of Cainan, apparently would make him Shelah's grandfather.
  - And Arpachshad became father to Shelah, and Shelah became father to Eber. (Genesis 10:24)
- And Arpachshad lived thirty-five years. Then he became father to Shelah. (Genesis 11:12)
- Shem, Arpachshad, Shelah. (1 Chronicles 1:24)
