

~ARROGANT (39)

[English, conceited, haughty, egotistical, bigheaded, superior, proud, overconfident, supercilious]

- The Psalmist, speaking as if man was an animal with a horn, which then uses its horn effectively to dominate others, counsels against doing so, saying; Do not speak with an **arrogant** neck as though inviting confrontation.
- Do not exalt your horn on high. Do not speak with an **arrogant** neck. (**Psalms 75:5**)
- The Psalmist could not endure anyone with an **arrogant** heart.
- Anyone slandering his companion in secrecy, him I silence. Anyone of haughty eyes and of **arrogant** heart, him I cannot endure. (**Psalms 101:5**)
- Those who are at ease are **arrogant** and treat others with contempt.
- Abundantly our soul has been gluttoned with the derision of those who are at ease, of the contempt on the part of the **arrogant** ones. (**Psalms 123:4**)
- **Arrogant** one's see their way as better and so all of their ways are sin.
- Haughty eyes and an **arrogant** heart, the lamp of the wicked ones, are sin. (**Proverbs 21:4**)
- **Arrogant** one's just stir up competition, but one's who rely on Yehowah will do well.
- He that is **arrogant** in soul stirs up contention, but he that is relying upon Yehowah will be made fat. (**Proverbs 28:25**)
