## ~ARTEMAS (15) (Ar'te-mas)

- A companion whom Paul considered sending to Titus in Crete.
- When I send Artemas or Tychicus to you, do your utmost to come to me at Nicopolis, for there is where I have decided to winter. (Titus 3:12)
- Perhaps as a replacement in order, that Titus might join Paul in Nicopolis. Since Paul's choice was to be between Artemas and Tychicus, Artemas was evidently well esteemed, as is indicated by Paul's comments about Tychicus at,
- Now in order that you may also know about my affairs, as to how I am doing, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you. (Ephesians 6:21)
- I am sending him to you for this very purpose, that you may know of the things having to do with us and that he may comfort your hearts. (Ephesians 6:22)
