## ~ARUMAH (23) (A-ru'mah) [Height, Exalted Place]

- A town in the territory of Ephraim in which Abimelech, the son of Jerubbaal, resided and from which he launched his attack on the Shechemites.
- And Abimelech continued to dwell in Arumah, and Zebul proceeded to drive Gaal and his brothers out from dwelling in Shechem. (Judges 9:41)
- It is tentatively identified with Khirbet el-`Ormah, Horvat el-`Urmeh, about 8 kilometers (5 miles) Southeast of Shechem. Some suggest that it is the same as the Rumah referred to at;
- Twenty-five years old was Jehoiakim when he began to reign, and for eleven years he reigned in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Zebidah the daughter of Pedaiah from Rumah. (2 Kings 23:36)
