~ASHARELAH (26) (Ash-a-re'lah)

- A son of Asaph serving in the service groups of musicians and singers at the house of Yehowah in the time of David.
- Further, David and the chiefs of the service groups separated for the service some of the sons of Asaph, Heman and Jeduthun the one's prophesying with the harps, with the stringed instruments and with the cymbals. And from their number the official men for their service came to be. (1 Chronicles 25:1)
- Of the sons of Asaph, Zaccur and Joseph and Nethaniah and Asharelah, the sons of Asaph under the control of Asaph the one prophesying under the control of the king. (1 Chronicles 25:2)
- It is probable that Jesharelah of verse 14 is a variation of his name.
- The seventh for Jesharelah, his sons and his brothers, twelve. (1 Chronicles 25:14)
