~ASHURITE (33) (Ash'ur-ite)

- A people subject to the kingship of Ish-bosheth, Saul's son.
- And to make him king over Gilead and the Ashurites and Jezreel and over Ephraim and Benjamin and over Israel, all of it. (2 Samuel 2:9)
- They are listed between Gilead and Jezreel. The Latin Vulgate and Syriac Peshitta here read Geshurites, while the Targums say Asherites.
- And the Asherites continued to dwell in among the Canaanites inhabiting the land, because they did not drive them out. (Judges 1:32)
- The name Asshurim is used at;
- And Jokshan became father to Sheba and Dedan. And the sons of Dedan became Asshurim and Letushim and Leummim. (Genesis 25:3)
