## ~ASNAH (21) (As'nah)

- The family head of certain Nethinim who returned from Babylonian exile to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- The sons of Asnah, the sons of Meunim, the sons of Nephusim. (Ezra 2:50)
- They are, however, omitted from a similar list in,
- The sons of Besai, the sons of Meunim, the sons of Nephushesim. (Nehemiah 7:52)
