[Greek, *a-spis*]

- A name popularly used today for **several unrelated poisonous snakes**. Greek, *a-spis*'.
- The word **asps** appears once in the Holy Bible, at;
- Their throat is an opened grave, they have used deceit with their tongues. Poison of **asps** is behind their lips. (**Romans 3:13**)
- Where the apostle Paul, speaking of sinners, says; Poison of **asps** is behind their lips. Here the apostle is quoting from;
- They have sharpened their tongue like that of a serpent, the venom of the horned viper is under their lips. (**Psalms 140:3**)
- The venom of the horned viper is under their lips. Therefore, the **asps** referred to at;
- Their throat is an opened grave, they have used deceit with their tongues. Poison of **asps** is behind their lips. (**Romans 3:13**)
- Must be **horned vipers**.
