

~ASSISTANCE (114)

[English, help, aid, support, backing, assist, Opposite of hindrance]

- Yehowah's angel cursed Meroz because he did not come to the **assistance** of Yehowah.
- Curse Meroz, said the angel of Yehowah, Curse its inhabitants incessantly, for they did not come to the **assistance** of Yehowah, to the **assistance** of Yehowah with the mighty ones. (**Judges 5:23**)
- Ahaz stripped Yehowah's house to get the **assistance** of the king of Assyria but no **assistance** was forthcoming.
- For Ahaz stripped the house of Yehowah and the house of the king and of the princes and thus made a gift to the king of Assyria, but it was of no **assistance** to him. (**2 Chronicles 28:21**)
- Righteous Job always provided **assistance** to those in need of his help.
- If I waved my hand to and fro against the fatherless boy, when I would see need of my **assistance** in the gate. (**Job 31:21**)
- The Psalmist asked for Yehowah his strength to come to his **assistance**.
- But you, O Yehowah, O do not keep far off. O you my strength, do make haste to my **assistance**. (**Psalms 22:19**)
- Do not conceal your face from me. Do not in anger turn your servant away. My **assistance** you must become. Do not forsake me and do not leave me, O my God of salvation. (**Psalms 27:9**)
- Take hold of buckler and large shield, and do rise up in **assistance** of me. (**Psalms 35:2**)
- Do make haste to my **assistance**, O Yehowah my salvation. (**Psalms 38:22**)
- Be pleased, O Yehowah, to deliver me. O Yehowah, to my **assistance** do make haste. (**Psalms 40:13**)

- But I am afflicted and poor. Yehowah himself takes account of me. You are my **assistance** and the Provider of escape for me. O my God, do not be too late. (**Psalms 40:17**)
- Do arise in **assistance** to us and redeem us for the sake of your loving-kindness. (**Psalms 44:26**)
- Do give us **assistance** from distress, as salvation by earthling man is worthless. (**Psalms 60:11**)
- For you have proved to be of **assistance** to me, and in the shadow of your wings I cry out joyfully. (**Psalms 63:7**)
- O God, to deliver me, O Yehowah, to my **assistance** do make haste. (**Psalms 70:1**)
- O God, do not keep far away from me. O my God, do hurry to my **assistance**. (**Psalms 71:12**)
- Unless Yehowah had been of **assistance** to me, in a little while my soul would have resided in silence. (**Psalms 94:17**)
- Do give us **assistance** from distress, as salvation by earthling man is worthless. (**Psalms 108:12**)
- Idol worshipping Israelites were asked who they would call to for **assistance** when their time came.
- And what will you men do at the day of being given attention and at the ruin, when it comes from far away? Toward whom will you flee for **assistance**, and where will you leave your glory. (**Isaiah 10:3**)
- The coastland cities looked to Ethiopia for **assistance** against Assyria. Also the Israelites looked to Egypt for military **assistance**.
- And the inhabitant of this coastland will be certain to say in that day, There is how our looked-for hope is, to which we fled for **assistance**, in order to be delivered because of the king of Assyria! And how shall we ourselves escape? (**Isaiah 20:6**)
- Woe to those going down to Egypt for **assistance**, those who rely on mere horses, and who put their trust in war chariots, because

they are numerous, and in steeds, because they are very mighty, but who have not looked to the Holy One of Israel and have not searched for Yehowah himself. ([Isaiah 31:1](#))

- Yehowah promised to rise up against those who would come to the **assistance** of evildoers.
- And he is also wise and will bring in what is calamitous, and he has not called back his own words, and he will certainly rise up against the house of evildoers and against the **assistance** of those practicing what is hurtful. ([Isaiah 31:2](#))
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; This is what you men should say to the king of Judah, the one sending you to me to inquire of me; Look! The military force of Pharaoh that is coming forth to you people for the purpose of **assistance** will have to go back to their land, Egypt. ([Jeremiah 37:7](#))
- Ethiopia was her full might, also Egypt, and that without limit. Put and the Libyans themselves proved to be of **assistance** to you. ([Nahum 3:9](#))
