

~ASSURANCE (36)

[English, pledge, declaration, word, guarantee, oath, promise, reassurance, declaration]

- Paul did not want to become ashamed of the **assurance** he had made to the Macedonians.
- Otherwise, in some way, if Macedonians should come with me and find you not ready, we, not to say you, should be put to shame in this **assurance** of ours. (2 Corinthians 9:4)
- Paul showed that accurate **knowledge** of the sacred secret of God which is Christ, would provide assurance to Christians.
- That their hearts may be comforted, that they may be harmoniously joined together in love and with a view to all the riches of the full **assurance** of their understanding, with a view to an accurate knowledge of the sacred secret of God, namely, Christ. (Colossians 2:2)
- Paul counseled Christians to be industrious in preaching the Good News so as to have the full **assurance** of the hope down to the end.
- But we desire each one of you to show the same industriousness so as to have the full **assurance** of the hope down to the end. (Hebrews 6:11)
- Paul showed that if our hearts are true then we can approach God with full **assurance** of his love.
- Let us approach with true hearts in the full **assurance** of faith, having had our hearts sprinkled from a wicked conscience and our bodies bathed with clean water. (Hebrews 10:22)
