[English, confidently, assuredly, with conviction, Opposite of, weakly]

- Yehowah through Jeremiah told the king of Judah that though he was like the Head of Lebanon he could be **assured** that Yehowah would make him like a wilderness.
- For this is what Yehowah has said concerning the house of the king of Judah, You are as Gilead to me, the head of Lebanon. **Assuredly** I shall make you a wilderness, as for the cities, not one will be inhabited. (**Jeremiah 22:6**)
- Paul showed that using the word **assuredly** is the equivalent of taking an oath as God spoke below;
- Saying; **Assuredly** in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply you. (**Hebrews 6:14**)
