

~ASTONISHED (73)

[English, surprised, amazed, astounded, dumbfounded, flabbergasted, incredulous, amazed, overwhelmed]

- Yehowah became **astonished** that there was no one among his people who would intercede in behalf of justice.
- And when he saw that there was no man, he began to show himself **astonished** that there was no one interposing. And his arm proceeded to save for him, and his own righteousness was the thing that supported him. (**Isaiah 59:16**)
- And I kept looking, but there was no helper, and I began to show myself **astonished**, but there was no one offering support. So my arm furnished me salvation, and my rage was what supported me. (**Isaiah 63:5**)
- Yehowah promised to remove his support of bread and water from his people who rebelled against him so that they would look **astonished** at one another.
- To the intent that they may be lacking bread and water and they may look **astonished** at one another and rot away in their error. (**Ezekiel 4:17**)
- The prophet Daniel was **astonished** upon realizing to whom the fulfillment of the dream pointed to, because it pointed to the king himself.
- At that time Daniel himself, whose name is Belteshazzar, was **astonished** for a moment, and his very thoughts began to frighten him. The king was answering and saying; O Belteshazzar, do not let the dream and the interpretation themselves frighten you. Belteshazzar was answering and saying; O my lord, may the dream apply to those hating you, and its interpretation to your adversaries. (**Daniel 4:19**)
- In Jesus' day the people were **astonished** at his ordering the unclean spirits away from people, thinking it might be a new teaching.
- Well, the people were all so **astonished** that they began a discussion among themselves, saying; What is this? A new

teaching! He authoritatively orders even the unclean spirits, and they obey him. ([Mark 1:27](#))

- Peter witnessed that certain women who had witnessed an supernatural sight at Jesus tomb **astonished** them with the news.
- Moreover, certain women from among us also **astonished** us, because they had been early to the memorial tomb ([Luke 24:22](#))
- Men listening to Jew speaking in their dialects were **astonished** to hear them speaking out about the Good News of God's Kingdom.
- Indeed, they were **astonished** and began to wonder and say; See here, all these who are speaking are Galileans, are they not? ([Acts of Apostles 2:7](#))
- Yes, they were all **astonished** and were in perplexity, saying one to another: What does this thing purport to be? ([Acts of Apostles 2:12](#))
- The disciples were **astonished** to see Peter free after he had been arrested and put in prison.
- But Peter remained there knocking. When they opened, they saw him and were astonished. ([Acts of Apostles 12:16](#))
