## ~ASTONISHED (73)

[English, surprised, amazed, astounded, dumbfounded, flabbergaster, incredulous, amazed, overwhelmed]

- Yehowah became astonished that there was no one among his people who would intercede in behalf of justice.
- And when he saw that there was no man, he began to show himself astonished that there was no one interposing. And his arm proceeded to save for him, and his own righteousness was the thing that supported him. (Isaiah 59:16)
- And I kept looking, but there was no helper, and I began to show myself astonished, but there was no one offering support. So my arm furnished me salvation, and my rage was what supported me. (Isaiah 63:5)
- Yehowah promised to remove his support of bread and water from his people who rebelled against him so that they would look astonished at one another.
- To the intent that they may be lacking bread and water and they may look astonished at one another and rot away in their error. (Ezekiel 4:17)
- The prophet Daniel was astonished upon realizing to whom the fulfillment of the dream pointed to, because it pointed to the king himself.
- At that time Daniel himself, whose name is Belteshazzar, was astonished for a moment, and his very thoughts began to frighten him. The king was answering and saying; O Belteshazzar, do not let the dream and the interpretation themselves frighten you. Belteshazzar was answering and saying; O my lord, may the dream apply to those hating you, and its interpretation to your adversaries. (Daniel 4:19)
- In Jesus' day the people were astonished at his ordering the unclean spirits away from people, thinking it might be a new teaching.
- Well, the people were all so astonished that they began a discussion among themselves, saying; What is this? A new

teaching! He authoritatively orders even the unclean spirits, and they obey him. (Mark 1:27)

- Peter witnessed that certain women who had witnessed an supernatural sight at Jesus tomb astonished them with the news.
- Moreover, certain women from among us also astonished us,
  because they had been early to the memorial tomb (Luke 24:22)
- Men listening to Jew speaking in their dialects were astonished to hear them speaking out about the Good News of God's Kingdom.
- Indeed, they were astonished and began to wonder and say; See here, all these who are speaking are Galileans, are they not? (Acts of Apostles 2:7)
- Yes, they were all astonished and were in perplexity, saying one to another: What does this thing purport to be? (Acts of Apostles 2:12)
- The disciples were astonished to see Peter free after he had been arrested and put in prison.
- But Peter remained there knocking. When they opened, they saw him and were astonished. (Acts of Apostles 12:16)
