

~ASTOUNDED (80)

[English, thunderstruck, flabbergasted, astonished, amazed, bowled over, wordless]

- Jeremiah asked why Yehowah was in their midst like a mighty man **astounded** and thus unable to act.
- Why do you become like a man **astounded**, like a mighty man that is unable to do any saving? Yet you yourself are in the midst of us, O Yehowah, and upon us it is that your own name has been called. Do not let us down. (**Jeremiah 14:9**)
- Listeners to Jesus found his way of teaching to be **astounding**.
- And they were **astounded** at his way of teaching, because his speech was with authority. (**Luke 4:32**)
- Now when Jesus finished these sayings, the effect was that the crowds were **astounded** at his way of teaching. (**Matthew 7:28**)
- And after coming into his home territory he began to teach them in their synagogue, so that they were **astounded** and said; Where did this man get this wisdom and these powerful works? (**Matthew 13:54**)
- On hearing that, the crowds were **astounded** at his teaching. (**Matthew 22:33**)
- And they became **astounded** at his way of teaching, for there he was teaching them as one having authority, and not as the scribes. (**Mark 1:22**)
- And the chief priests and the scribes heard it, and they began to seek how to destroy him, for they were in fear of him, for all the crowd was continually being **astounded** at his teaching. (**Mark 11:18**)
- When it became Sabbath, he started teaching in the synagogue, and the greater number of those listening were **astounded** and said; Where did this man get these things? And why should this wisdom have been given this man, and such powerful works be performed through his hands? (**Mark 6:2**)

- Men also were **astounded** at Jesus ability to heal and do miraculous works.
- Well, they all began to be **astounded** at the majestic power of God. Now as they were all marveling at all the things he was doing, he said to his disciples: (**Luke 9:43**)
- Indeed, they were being **astounded** in a most extraordinary way and they said; He has done all things well. He even makes the deaf hear and the speechless speak. (**Mark 7:37**)
- Jesus disciples were **astounded** when he told them that rich men were not going to be in the Kingdom.
- They became still more **astounded** and said to him; Who, in fact, can be saved? (**Mark 10:26**)
- Jesus parents were **astounded** when they found him in the temple and chastised him for their distress.
- Now when they saw him they were **astounded**, and his mother said to him; Child, why did you treat us this way? Here your father and I in mental distress have been looking for you. (**Luke 2:48**)
- The proconsul upon seeing the man struck with blindness for interfering with Paul's preaching work, was **astonished** and immediately became a believer.
- Then the proconsul, upon seeing what had happened, became a believer, as he was **astounded** at the teaching of Yehowah. (**Acts of Apostles 13:12**)
