(At'a-roth) [Crowns, that is, circular enclosures]

- A town along the boundary between the territories of Ephraim and Benjamin.
- And it went out from Bethel belonging to Luz and passed over to the boundary of the Archites at Ataroth. (Joshua 16:2)
- It is evidently the same as Ataroth-addar referred to at;
- And the boundary of the sons of Ephraim by their families came to be, yes, the boundary of their inheritance toward the east came to be Ataroth-addar, as far as Upper Beth-horon. (Joshua 16:5)
- And the boundary passed over from there to Luz, at the southern slope of Luz, that is to say; Bethel, and the boundary went down to Ataroth-addar upon the mountain that is on the south of Lower Beth-horon. (Joshua 18:13)
- In this latter verse it is presented as forming part of the North boundary of Benjamin and as located upon the mountain that is on the south of Lower Beth-horon.
