

~ATTENDANTS (208)

- Abraham and Isaac had **attendants** when they traveled to Mount Moriah to sacrifice Isaac.
- So Abraham got up early in the morning and saddled his ass and took two of his **attendants** with him and Isaac his son, and he split the wood for the burnt offering. Then he rose and went on the trip to the place that the true God designated to him. (**Genesis 22:3**)
- Abraham now said to his **attendants**; You stay here with the ass, but I and the boy want to go on over there and worship and return to you. (**Genesis 22:5**)
- After that Abraham returned to his **attendants**, and they got up and went their way together to Beersheba, and Abraham continued to dwell at Beersheba. (**Genesis 22:19**)
- Rebecca had **attendants** who went with her to Isaac when she was given in marriage to Isaac.
- After that Rebekah and her lady **attendants** rose and they went riding on the camels and following the man, and the servant took Rebekah and got on his way. (**Genesis 24:61**)
- Pharaoh's daughter had female **attendants** who went with her to bathe in the Nile where she found Moses in the ark.
- After a while Pharaoh's daughter came down to bathe in the Nile River, and her female **attendants** were walking by the side of the Nile River. And she caught sight of the ark in the middle of the reeds. Immediately she sent her slave girl that she might get it. (**Exodus 2:5**)
- Balaam went to curse Israel and two **attendants** were with him.
- And the anger of God began to blaze because he was going, and Yehowah's angel proceeded to station himself in the road to resist him. And he was riding upon his she-ass, and two **attendants** of his were with him. (**Numbers 22:22**)

- The **attendants** who gave uncooked meat to Elis sons sinned greatly.
- And the sin of the **attendants** came to be very great before Yehowah, for the men treated the offering of Yehowah with disrespect. (**1 Samuel 2:17**)
- Saul's father Kish told Saul to take some **attendants** and go look for his she-asses.
- And the she-asses belonging to Kish the father of Saul got lost. So Kish said to Saul his son; Take, please, with you one of the **attendants** and get up, go, look for the she-asses. (**1 Samuel 9:3**)
- One of Saul's **attendants** recommended David as a player of music to calm his soul.
- And one of the **attendants** proceeded to answer and say; Look! I have seen how a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite is skilled at playing, and he is a valiant, mighty man and a man of war and an intelligent speaker and a well-formed man, and Yehowah is with him. (**1 Samuel 16:18**)
- Absalom commanded his **attendants** to strike down Amnon for this sin with Tamar his sister.
- Then Absalom commanded his **attendants**, saying; See, please, that just as soon as Amnon's heart is in a merry mood with wine, and I shall certainly say to you; Strike down Amnon! You must then put him to death. Do not be afraid. Have not I myself commanded you? Be strong and prove yourselves to be valiant men. (**2 Samuel 13:28**)
- And Absalom's **attendants** proceeded to do to Amnon just as Absalom had commanded, and all the other sons of the king began to rise up and mount each one his mule and take to flight. (**2 Samuel 13:29**)
- Ten **attendants** of Joab who normally carried his weapons struck Absalom so that he died.
- Then ten **attendants** carrying Joab's weapons came around and struck Absalom, that they might put him to death. (**2 Samuel**

18:15)

- The Shunamite woman took her **attendants** and went up to the man of the true God for assistance.
- She now called her husband and said; Do send me, please, one of the **attendants** and one of the she-asses, and let me run as far as the man of the true God and return. (**2 Kings 4:22**)
- At that Naaman said; Go on, take two talents. And he kept urging him and finally bound up two talents of silver in two bags, with two changes of garments, and gave them to two of his **attendants**, that they might carry them before him. (**2 Kings 5:23**)
- Then Isaiah said to them; This is what you should say to your Lord; This is what Yehowah has said; Do not be afraid because of the words that you have heard with which the **attendants** of the king of Assyria spoke abusively of me. (**2 Kings 19:6**)
- As for me and my brothers and my **attendants** and the men of the guard who were behind me, we were not taking off our garments, each one having his missile in his right hand. (**Nehemiah 4:23**)
- And also I, my brothers and my **attendants** are giving money and grain on loan among them. Let us, please, leave off this lending on interest. (**Nehemiah 5:10**)
- As for the former governor's that were prior to me, they had made it heavy upon the people, and they kept taking from them for bread and wine daily forty silver shekels. Also, their **attendants** themselves domineered over the people. As for me, I did not do that way on account of the fear of God. (**Nehemiah 5:15**)
- And, what is more, in the work of this wall I took a hand, and not a field did we acquire, and all my **attendants** were collected together there for the work. (**Nehemiah 5:16**)
- And it came about that, as soon as the gates of Jerusalem had grown shadowy before the Sabbath, I immediately said the word and the doors began to be closed. I said further that they should not open them until after the Sabbath and some of my own

- attendants** I stationed at the gates that no burden might come in on the Sabbath day. (**Nehemiah 13:19**)
- Then the kings **attendants**, his ministers, said; Let them seek young women, virgins, beautiful in appearance, for the king. (**Esther 2:2**)
 - Then the king said; What honor and great thing has been done to Mordecai for this? To this the kings **attendants**, his ministers, said; Nothing has been done with him. (**Esther 6:3**)
 - Accordingly the kings **attendants** said to him; Here is Haman standing in the courtyard. So the king said; Let him come in. (**Esther 6:5**)
 - When the Sabeans came making a raid and taking them, and the **attendants** they struck down with the edge of the sword, and I got to escape, only I by myself, to tell you. (**Job 1:15**)
 - While this one was yet speaking that one came and proceeded to say; The very fire of God fell from the heavens and went blazing among the sheep and the **attendants** and eating them up, and I got to escape, only I by myself, to tell you. (**Job 1:16**)
 - While that one was yet speaking another one came and proceeded to say; The Chaldeans made up three bands and went dashing against the camels and taking them, and the **attendants** they struck down with the edge of the sword. I got to escape, only I by myself, to tell you. (**Job 1:17**)
 - When the Almighty was yet with me, when my **attendants** were all around me! (**Job 29:5**)
 - It has sent forth its lady **attendants**, that it may call out on top of the heights of the town. (**Proverbs 9:3**)
 - Then Isaiah said to them; This is what you should say to your lord, This is what Yehowah has said; Do not be afraid because of the words that you have heard with which the **attendants** of the king of Assyria spoke abusively of me. (**Isaiah 37:6**)
 - But Peter kept following him at a good distance, as far as the courtyard of the High Priest, and, after going inside, he was sitting with the house **attendants** to see the outcome. (**Matthew**

26:58)

- But Peter, from a good distance, followed him as far as in the courtyard of the High Priest, and he was sitting together with the house **attendants** and warming himself before a bright fire. (**Mark 14:54**)

- Just as those who from the beginning became eyewitnesses and **attendants** of the message delivered these to us. (**Luke 1:2**)
- And the Lord said; Who really is the faithful steward, the discreet one, whom his master will appoint over his body of **attendants** to keep giving them their measure of food supplies at the proper time? (**Luke 12:42**)
