- And Avvim and Parah and Ophrah. (Joshua 18:23)

- It may have been populated by remaining members of the tribe of the Avvim. It is identified with Khirbet Haiyan, Horvat Hayan, about 4 kilometers (2.5 miles) East-Southeast of Bethel or Beitin, according to [F.M. Abel. Géographie de (Lamentations Palestine, Paris, 1938, Vol. II, p. 257.]
