- Job likens those who curse life to those who would awaken Leviathan.
- Let cursers of the day execrate it, those ready to awaken Leviathan. (Job 3:8)
- The Psalmist started his day with songs of praise awakening the dawn.
- Do awake, O my glory, do awake, O stringed instrument. You too, O harp. I will awaken the dawn. (Psalms 57:8)
