

## ~AWARE (196)

[English, conscious, alert, attentive, awake, responsive, sentient, sensitive, Opposite of, **unconscious**]

- When Hagar became **aware** that she was pregnant she showed disrespect for Yehowah's true wife Sarai.
- Accordingly he had relations with Hagar, and she became pregnant. When she became **aware** that she was pregnant, then her mistress began to be despised in her eyes. (**Genesis 16:4**)
- At this Sarai said to Abram, The violence done me be upon you. I myself gave my maidservant over to your bosom, and she became **aware** that she was pregnant, and I began to be despised in her eyes. May Yehowah judge between me and you. (**Genesis 16:5**)
- Jacob counseled Esau that he was **aware** of the delicate nature of his children and cattle bearing young.
- But he said to him; My lord is **aware** that the children are delicate and sheep and cattle that are giving suck are in my charge, and should they drive them too quickly for one day, then the whole flock will certainly die. (**Genesis 33:13**)
- Ruth had an fine reputation for everyone was **aware** that she was an excellent woman.
- And now, my daughter, do not be afraid. All that you say I shall do for you, for everyone in the gate of my people is **aware** that you are an excellent woman. (**Ruth 3:11**)
- All Israel became **aware** that Samuel was Yehowah's prophet.
- And all Israel from Dan to Beer-sheba became **aware** that Samuel was one accredited for the position of prophet to Yehowah. (**1 Samuel 3:20**)
- All Israel was **aware** that David and the men with him were valiant men.
- And even the valiant man whose heart is as the heart of the lion

will himself surely soften in weakness, for all Israel is **aware** that your father is a mighty man and so, too, are the valiant men that are with him. (2 Samuel 17:10)

- All of the king's servants were fully **aware** that to enter into his presence without permission could cause their deaths.
- All the king's servants and the people of the king's jurisdictional districts are **aware** that, as regards any man or woman that comes in to the king at the inner courtyard who is not called, his one Law is to have him put to death, only in case the king holds out to him the golden scepter, he will also certainly stay alive. As for me, I have not been called to come in to the king now for thirty days. (Esther 4:11)
- Yehowah himself is **aware** of the faultless ones and no one can take their inheritance from him.
- Yehowah is **aware** of the days of the faultless ones, and their very inheritance will continue even to time indefinite. (Psalms 37:18)
- Yehowah is **aware** of the secrets of all mankind's hearts.
- Will not God himself search this out? For he is **aware** of the secrets of the heart. (Psalms 44:21)
- The Psalmist was aware of the **wonderful** way in which he was made.
- I shall laud you because in a fear-inspiring way I am wonderfully made. Your works are wonderful, as my soul is very well **aware**. (Psalms 139:14)
- The heart is **aware** of the bitterness of one's soul.
- The heart is **aware** of the bitterness of one's soul, and with its rejoicing no stranger will intermeddle. (Proverbs 14:10)
- Those who reject the good way will perish **unaware** suddenly.
- For their disaster will arise so suddenly, that who is **aware** of the extinction of those who are for a change? (Proverbs 24:22)

- The stupid ones are not **aware** of doing bad.
- Guard your feet whenever you go to the house of the true God, and let there be a drawing near to hear, rather than to give a sacrifice as the stupid one's do, for they are not **aware** of doing what is bad. (**Ecclesiastes 5:1**)
- The congregator was **aware** that it would turn out well with those fearing the true God.
- Although a sinner may be doing bad a hundred times and continuing a long time as he pleases, yet I am also **aware** that it will turn out well with those fearing the true God, because they were in fear of him. (**Ecclesiastes 8:12**)

- For I took all this to my heart, even to search out all this, that the righteous one's and the wise ones and their works are in the hand of the true God. Mankind are not **aware** of either the love or the hate that were all prior to them. (**Ecclesiastes 9:1**)

- Just as you are not **aware** of what is the way of the spirit in the bones in the belly of her that is pregnant, in like manner you do not know the work of the true God, who does all things. (**Ecclesiastes 11:5**)
- Nebuchadnezzar was **aware** that his counselors were merely stalling for time.
- The king was answering and saying; For a fact, I am **aware** that time is what you men are trying to gain, forasmuch as you have perceived that the word is being promulgated by me. (**Daniel 2:8**)
- Jonah was **aware** that he was the reason for the great tempest around them.
- So he said to them; Lift me up and hurl me into the sea, and the sea will become still for you, because I am **aware** that it is on my

account that this great tempest is upon you. (**Jonah 1:12**)

- Jesus asked if they were not **aware** that things we eat pass through the intestines and into the sewer

- So he said to them; Are you also without perception like them? Are you not **aware** that nothing from outside that passes into a man can defile him. (**Mark 7:18**)
- **Aware** of this, Jesus said to them; Why do you try to make trouble for the woman? For she did a fine deed toward me. (**Matthew 26:10**)
- Pilate was **aware** that out of envy the chief priests had handed Jesus over to him to be impaled.
- For he was **aware** that out of envy they had handed him over. (**Matthew 27:18**)
- For he was **aware** that because of envy the chief priests had handed him over. (**Mark 15:10**)
- The Lord became aware of what the Pharisees had heard about John the Baptist.
- When, now, the Lord became **aware** that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John. (**John 4:1**)
- Jesus healed a man while being **aware** of his long-standing sickness.
- Seeing this man lying down, and being **aware** that he had already been sick a long time, Jesus said to him; Do you want to become sound in health? (**John 5:6**)
- Peter said that Christ was **aware** of Peter's affection for him.
- He said to him the third time; Simon son of John, do you have affection for me? Peter became grieved that he said to him the

third time; Do you have affection for me? So he said to him, Lord, you know all things; You are **aware** that I have affection for you. Jesus said to him; Feed my little sheep. (**John 21:17**)

- Paul counseled elders to readjust a man who takes a false step before he is **aware** of it. Such readjustment no doubt including making him **aware** of the seriousness of what had been done.
- Brothers, even though a man takes some false step before he is **aware** of it, you who have spiritual qualifications try to readjust such a man in a spirit of mildness, as you each keep an eye on yourself, for fear you also may be tempted. (**Galatians 6:1**)
