**(Az'gad) [Strong Is Gad]**

- The head of a paternal house, some of whose members returned to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel in **537 B.C.E.**
- The sons of **Azgad**, a thousand two hundred and twenty-two. (**Ezra 2:12**)
- The sons of **Azgad**, two thousand three hundred and twenty-two. (**Nehemiah 7:17**)
- And some with Ezra in **468 B.C.E.**
- And of the sons of **Azgad**, Johanan the son of Hakkatan, and with him a hundred and ten males. (**Ezra 8:12**)
- It was probably one of his descendants who attested to the **trustworthy arrangement** negotiated by Nehemiah.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a **trustworthy arrangement**, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (**Nehemiah 9:38**)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (**Nehemiah 10:1**)
- The heads of the people, Parosh, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani. (**Nehemiah 10:14**)
- Bunni, **Azgad**, Bebai. (**Nehemiah 10:15**)
