~AZGAD (33) (Az'gad) [Strong Is Gad]

- The head of a paternal house, some of whose members returned to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E.
- The sons of Azgad, a thousand two hundred and twenty-two. (Ezra 2:12)
- The sons of Azgad, two thousand three hundred and twenty-two. (Nehemiah 7:17)
- And some with Ezra in 468 B.C.E.
- And of the sons of Azgad, Johanan the son of Hakkatan, and with him a hundred and ten males. (Ezra 8:12)
- It was probably one of his descendants who attested to the trustworthy arrangement negotiated by Nehemiah.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- The heads of the people, Parosh, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani. (Nehemiah 10:14)
- Bunni, Azgad, Bebai. (Nehemiah 10:15)
