## ~BAAL-HAMON (16) (Ba'al-ha'mon) [Owner of a Crowd, or Multitude]

- A place mentioned at;
- There was a vineyard that Solomon happened to have in Baal-hamon. He gave the vineyard over to the keepers. Each one would bring in for its fruitage a thousand silver pieces. (Song of Solomon 8:11)
- As the location of a productive vineyard of King Solomon. No indication is given as to its site. While many view it as a literal location, some suggest that it is used in this poetic writing figuratively to represent the realm over which Solomon reigned.
