~BAANA 1 (23) (Ba'a-na)

- One of the 12 deputies whom Solomon appointed to secure food for the king's household. Baana's assignment was the fifth-listed district, primarily the fertile valleys of Megiddo and Jezreel. Son of Ahilud, possibly the brother of Solomon's recorder Jehoshaphat.
- Elihoreph and Ahijah, the sons of Shisha, secretaries, Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder. (1 Kings 4:3)
- And Solomon had twelve deputies over all Israel, and they provided the king and his household with food. It would devolve upon each one to provide the food one month in the year. (1 Kings 4:7)
- Baana the son of Ahilud, in Taanach and Megiddo and all Bethshean, which is beside Zarethan below Jezreel, from Beth-shean to Abel-meholah to the region of Jokmeam. (1 Kings 4:12)
