~BABES (67)

[English, babies, infants, little ones, tots, children, toddlers, kids, newborns]

- Jesus praised Yehowah his father for revealing his hidden things to babes while keeping them from scholarly and intellectual ones.
- At that time Jesus said in response; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and intellectual one's and have revealed them to babes. (Matthew 11:25)
- In that very hour he became overjoyed in the Holy Spirit and said; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have carefully hidden these things from wise and intellectual ones, and have revealed them to babes. Yes, O Father, because to do thus came to be the way approved by you. (Luke 10:21)
- Jesus reproved the Pharisees scripturally by saying it was proper for these babes to parise his triumphal entry to Jerusalem.
- And said to him; Do you hear what these are saying? Jesus said to them; Yes. Did you never read this; Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings you have furnished praise? (Matthew 21:16)
- Paul counseled those who would like to teach babes in the truth, to watch themselves and their teaching and behavior.
- A corrector of the unreasonable ones, a teacher of babes, and having the framework of the knowledge and of the truth in the Law. (Romans 2:20)
- Paul counseled the Corinthians that he would like to speak to them as men, but was not able to for they were as yet babes in Christ.
- And so, brothers, I was not able to speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to fleshly men, as to babes in Christ. (1 Corinthians 3:1)
- Paul's counseled Christians to be knowledgeable and wise but to be babes as to badness.

- Brothers, do not become young children in powers of understanding, but be babes as to badness, yet become full-grown in powers of understanding. (1 Corinthians 14:20)
- Paul's showed that when we as Christian were babes we were enslaved by the elementary things of the world.
- Likewise we also, when we were babes, continued enslaved by the elementary things belonging to the world. (Galatians 4:3)
- Paul showed that we should not be babes who have no direction or will in life and so they are carried here and there by every wind of teaching.
- In order, that we should no longer be babes, tossed about as by waves and carried hither and thither by every wind of teaching by means of the trickery of men, by means of cunning in contriving error. (Ephesians 4:14)
