

~BABES (67)

[English, babies, infants, little ones, tots, children, toddlers, kids, newborns]

- **Jesus praised Yehowah his father for revealing his hidden things to **babes** while keeping them from scholarly and intellectual ones.**
- **At that time Jesus said in response; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and intellectual one's and have revealed them to **babes**. (Matthew 11:25)**
- **In that very hour he became overjoyed in the Holy Spirit and said; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have carefully hidden these things from wise and intellectual ones, and have revealed them to **babes**. Yes, O Father, because to do thus came to be the way approved by you. (Luke 10:21)**
- **Jesus reproved the Pharisees scripturally by saying it was proper for these **babes** to parise his triumphal entry to Jerusalem.**
- **And said to him; Do you hear what these are saying? Jesus said to them; Yes. Did you never read this; Out of the mouth of **babes** and sucklings you have furnished praise? (Matthew 21:16)**
- **Paul counseled those who would like to teach **babes** in the truth, to watch themselves and their teaching and behavior.**
- **A corrector of the unreasonable ones, a teacher of **babes**, and having the framework of the knowledge and of the truth in the Law. (Romans 2:20)**
- **Paul counseled the Corinthians that he would like to speak to them as men, but was not able to for they were as yet **babes** in Christ.**
- **And so, brothers, I was not able to speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to fleshly men, as to **babes** in Christ. (1 Corinthians 3:1)**
- **Paul's counseled Christians to be knowledgeable and wise but to be **babes** as to badness.**

- Brothers, do not become young children in powers of understanding, but be **babes** as to badness, yet become full-grown in powers of understanding. (**1 Corinthians 14:20**)
- Paul's showed that when we as Christian were **babes** we were enslaved by the elementary things of the world.
- Likewise we also, when we were **babes**, continued enslaved by the elementary things belonging to the world. (**Galatians 4:3**)
- Paul showed that we should not be **babes** who have no direction or will in life and so they are carried here and there by every wind of teaching.
- In order, that we should no longer be **babes**, tossed about as by waves and carried hither and thither by every wind of teaching by means of the trickery of men, by means of cunning in contriving error. (**Ephesians 4:14**)
