- Paul reasons that when he was a **babe** he reasoned as a **babe**, but now that he had become a man, he has put away such traits.
- When I was a **babe**, I used to speak as a babe, to think as a babe, to reason as a babe, but now that I have become a man, I have done away with the traits of a babe. (**1 Corinthians 13:11**)
- Paul states that as long as the heir is a **babe** he does not differ at all from a slave for his receiving of the inheritance is far off.
- Now I say that as long as the heir is a **babe** he does not differ at all from a slave, lord of all things though he is. (**Galatians 4:1**)
- Paul shows that those needing milk as a spiritual food are **babes** but solid food, food requiring chewing, spiritually discernment and wisdom, belongs to more mature ones.
- For everyone that partakes of milk is unacquainted with the word of righteousness, for he is a **babe**. (**Hebrews 5:13**)
