- Azmaveth the Baharumite, Eliahba the Shaalbonite. (1 Chronicles 11:33)
- And the Bar-humite at;
- Abi-albon the Arbathite, Azmaveth the Bar-humite. (2 Samuel 23:31)
- Shimei, the reviler of fleeing King David, was also a **Baharumite**.
- Then Shimei the son of Gera the Benjaminite, who was from Bahurim, hurried and went down with the men of Judah to meet King David. (2 Samuel 19:16)
- And here there is with you Shimei the son of Gera the Benjaminite from Bahurim, and he it was that called down evil upon me with a painful malediction on the day that I was going to Mahanaim, and he it was that came down to meet me at the Jordan, so that I swore to him by Yehowah, saying; I shall not put you to death by the sword. (1 Kings 2:8)
