(Bas'e-math) [Perfumed, Balsam Oil, Spicy]

- A wife of Esau. She was a daughter of Elon the Hittite, therefore either the same person as Adah or her sister. Basemath was a source of bitterness to Isaac and Rebekah.
- And Esau grew to be forty years old. Then he took as wife Judith the daughter of Beeri the Hittite and also Basemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite. (Genesis 26:34)
- And they were a source of bitterness of spirit to Isaac and Rebekah. (Genesis 26:35)
- After that Rebekah kept saying to Isaac: I have come to abhor this life of mine because of the daughters of Heth. If Jacob ever takes a wife from the daughters of Heth like these from the daughters of the land, of what good is life to me? (Genesis 27:46)
- Then Esau saw that the daughters of Canaan were displeasing in the eyes of Isaac his father. (Genesis 28:8)
- Esau took his wives from the daughters of Canaan. Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite and Oholibamah the daughter of Anah, the granddaughter of Zibeon the Hivite. (Genesis 36:2)
