- A liquid measure amounting to a tenth of a homer or cor, and corresponding to the dry-measure ephah.
- Accurate scales and an accurate ephah and an accurate bath measure you men should come to have. (Ezekiel 45:10)
- As regards the ephah and the bath measure, there should come to be but one fixed amount, for the bath to carry a tenth of a homer and the tenth of the homer an ephah, with reference to the homer, its required amount should prove to be. (Ezekiel 45:11)
- And as for the allowance of the oil, there is the bath measure of the oil. The bath is a tenth of the cor. Ten baths are a homer, because ten baths are a homer. (Ezekiel 45:14)
- On the basis of jar fragments bearing the designation bath in ancient Hebrew characters, it has been estimated that the bath measure equaled 22 Liters, (5.81 gallons)
