

## ~BATH (23)

- A liquid measure amounting to a tenth of a homer or cor, and corresponding to the dry-measure ephah.
- Accurate scales and an accurate ephah and an accurate **bath** measure you men should come to have. (**Ezekiel 45:10**)
- As regards the ephah and the **bath** measure, there should come to be but one fixed amount, for the **bath to carry a tenth of a homer and the tenth of the homer an ephah**, with reference to the homer, its required amount should prove to be. (**Ezekiel 45:11**)
- And as for the allowance of the oil, there is the **bath** measure of the oil. The **bath** is a tenth of the cor. Ten **baths** are a homer, because ten **baths** are a homer. (**Ezekiel 45:14**)
- On the basis of jar fragments bearing the designation **bath** in ancient **Hebrew** characters, it has been estimated that the **bath** measure equaled 22 Liters, (5.81 gallons)
