[English, happy, healthy, glowing, sunny, joyful, Opposite of, unhappy]

- Yehowah's eyes are described as beaming for he sees all of the works of the sons of mankind.
- Yehowah is in his holy temple. Yehowah, in the heavens is his throne. His own eyes behold, his own beaming eyes examine the sons of men. (Psalms 11:4)
- David with beaming eyes stayed fixed on his purpose to build a house for the true God Yehowah.
- I will not give sleep to my eyes, nor slumber to my own beaming eyes. (Psalms 132:4)
- The congregator encourages his sons to stay on a course of righteousness with their eyes beaming straight ahead of them.
- As for your eyes, straight ahead they should look, yes, your own beaming eyes should gaze straight in front of you. (Proverbs 4:25)
- The congregator encourages his son to resolve a difficulty between him and his fellowman not letting sleep keep his own beaming eyes from following through in the matter.
- Do not give any sleep to your eyes, nor any slumber to your beaming eyes. (Proverbs 6:4)
- There is a generation of men whose beaming eyes, their own view of themselves, is lifted up, meaning that they view themselves as important one's over others.
- There is a generation whose eyes have become 0 how lofty! And whose beaming eyes are lifted up. (Proverbs 30:13)
- Jeremiah lamented that his own beaming eyes must run down with tears over the fall of his people.
- And that they may hurry and raise up over us a lamentation. And may our eyes run down with tears and our own beaming eyes

trickle with waters. (Jeremiah 9:18)

- Jerusalem had a beaming splendor among the nations of the earth but Yehowah brought it down to the earth through the tyrants of the nations.
- Therefore here I am bringing upon you strangers, the tyrants of the nations, and they will certainly draw their swords against the beauty of your wisdom and profane your beaming splendor. (Ezekiel 28:7)
- The heart of Tyre became haughty because of its beaming splendor.
- Your heart became haughty because of your beauty. You brought your wisdom to ruin on account of your beaming splendor. Onto the earth I will throw you. Before kings I will set you, for them to look upon you. (Ezekiel 28:17)
