## ~BEAMS (71)

[English, rays, shafts of light, sunbeams, big smile, grin, smile, Opposite of scowl]

- Yehowah's house built by Solomon had beams and rows of cedarwood.
- Further, he continued building the house that he might finish it, and covered in the house with beams and rows in cedarwood. (1 Kings 6:9)
- And he went on to build the inner courtyard with three rows of hewn stone and a row of beams of cedarwood. (1 Kings 6:36)
- As for the great courtyard, round about were three rows of hewn stone and a row of beams of cedarwood, and this also for the inner courtyard of the house of Yehowah, and for the porch of the house. (1 Kings 7:12)
- The beams of our grand house are cedars, our rafters juniper trees. (Song of Solomon 1:17)
- Also the House of the Forest had a similar construction with beams of cedarwood.
- And he proceeded to build the House of the Forest of Lebanon a hundred cubits in its length, and fifty cubits in its width, and thirty cubits in its height, upon four rows of pillars of cedarwood, and there were beams of cedarwood upon the pillars. (1 Kings 7:2)
- So they gave it to the craftsmen and the builders to buy hewn stones and timbers for clamps and to build with beams the houses that the kings of Judah had brought to ruin. (2 Chronicles 34:11)
- Job refers to the beams of dawn as the light sometimes looks as it comes through low clouds near the horizon.
- Let the stars of its twilight grow dark. Let it wait for the light and there be none. And let it not see the beams of dawn. (Job

- Job felt that his life was like a place of gloom without beams of light.
- To the land of obscurity like gloom, of deep shadow and disorder, where it beams no more than gloom does. (Job 10:22)
- Leviathan is so fearsome that its eyes are like beams of dawn.
- Its very sneezings flash forth light, and its eyes are like the beams of dawn. (Job 41:18)
- The Psalmist bemoans the way Yehowah's enemies used iron tipped beams to destroy his sanctuary.
- And now the very engravings of it, one and all, they strike even with hatchet and iron-tipped beams. (Psalms 74:6)
- Yehowah is described as one who builds his upper chambers with beams in the very waters of heaven.
- The One building his upper chambers with beams in the very waters, making the clouds his chariot, walking upon the wings of the wind. (Psalms 104:3)
