## ~BEBAI 1 (38) (Be'bai)

- A household head whose descendants, over 600, returned to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The sons of Bebai, six hundred and twenty-three. (Ezra 2:11)
- The sons of Bebai, six hundred and twenty-eight. (Nehemiah 7:16)
- Twenty-nine more came with Ezra in 468 B.C.E.
- And of the sons of Bebai, Zechariah the son of Bebai, and with him twenty-eight males. (Ezra 8:11)
- Four of the first group had taken foreign wives, which they put away at the insistence of Ezra.
- And of the sons of Bebai, Jehohanan, Hananiah, Zabbai, Athlai. (Ezra 10:28)
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
