~BEEROTHITE (57)

(Be-er'oth-ite) [Of or Belonging to Beeroth]

- A resident or native of Beeroth. At the time of the Israelites entry into Canaan its inhabitants were Hivites. The territory was thereafter assigned to Benjamin, and the Hivite residents became gatherers of wood and drawers of water.
- Then the sons of Israel pulled out and came to their cities on the third day, and their cities were Gibeon and Chephirah and Beeroth and Kiriath-jearim. (Joshua 9:17)
- Accordingly Joshua constituted them on that day gatherers of wood and drawers of water for the assembly and for Yehowah's altar, down to this day, at the place that he should choose.

 (Joshua 9:27)
- And the cities of the tribe of the sons of Benjamin by their families proved to be Jericho and Beth-hoglah and Emek-keziz. (Joshua 18:21)
- Gibeon and Ramah and Beeroth. (Joshua 18:25)
- The assassins of Ish-bosheth, namely, Baanah and Rechab, were sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, of the sons of Benjamin.
- And there were two men, chiefs of the marauding bands, that happened to belong to the son of Saul, the name of the one being Baanah and the name of the other being Rechab, the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, of the sons of Benjamin, for Beeroth, too, used to be counted as part of Benjamin. (2 Samuel 4:2)
- And the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, Rechab and Baanah, proceeded to go and come to the house of Ish-bosheth about when the day had heated up, as he was taking his noonday siesta. (2 Samuel 4:5)
- However, David answered Rechab and Baanah his brother, the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, and said to them. As Yehowah who redeemed my soul out of all distress is living. (2 Samuel 4:9)
- Naharai, one of David's mighty men, is called the Beerothite in

- Zelek the Ammonite, Naharai the Beerothite, armor-bearers of Joab the son of Zeruiah. (2 Samuel 23:37)
- · And the Berothite in,
- Zelek the Ammonite, Naharai the Berothite, the armor-bearer of Joab the son of Zeruiah. (1 Chronicles 11:39)
