~BENE-BERAK (20) (Ben'e-be'rak) [Sons of Berak]

- A city of Dan identified with Ibn Ibraq, or Kheiriyeh, Horvat Bene-beraq, 8 kilometers (5 miles) East-Southeast of Tel Aviv-Yafo or Joppa.
- It was for the tribe of the sons of Dan by their families that the seventh lot came out. (Joshua 19:40)
- And Jehud and Bene-berak and Gath-rimmon. (Joshua 19:45)
- The Arabic name Ibn Ibraq corresponds to the Hebrew Bene-berak. In a prism of Sennacherib, that emperors account of the Assyrian campaign against Hezekiah states that he besieged Beth-Dagon, Joppa, Banai-Barqa or Bene-berak, Azuru. [Ancient Near Eastern Texts, edited by J. Pritchard, 1974, p. 287]
