~BERACAH 2 (20) (Ber'a-cah) [Blessing]

- A low plain in Judah lying between Bethlehem and Hebron. It is presently identified with the Wadi el-`Arrub, and nearby Khirbet Bereikut, Berakhot, seems to preserve evidence of the original name. This valley runs East-West, connecting the hill country of Judah with the wilderness area West of the Salt Sea.
- Following the miraculous victory over the combined forces of Ammon, Moab, and Edom, Jehoshaphat congregated the people at this low plain to bless Yehowah, hence the name of the Low Plain of Beracah, meaning Blessing.
- And on the fourth day they congregated together at the low plain of Beracah, for there they blessed Yehowah. That is why they called the name of that place Low Plain of Beracah, until today. (2 Chronicles 20:26)
