~BEREAVE (51)

[English, loss of loved one, lose something valuable]

- Yehowah promised to send wild beast against his people to bereave them of their children if they turned away from true worship.
- And I will send the wild beasts of the field among you, and they will certainly bereave you of children and cut off your domestic animals and reduce the number of you, and your roads will actually be desolated. (Leviticus 26:22)
- Yehowah promised to bereave them through the sword as one of the maledictions he pronounced upon Israel.
- Outdoors a sword will bereave them, and indoors fright, of both young man and virgin, suckling together with gray-haired man. (Deuteronomy 32:25)
- Later Jesus fulfilled his earlier promise by bereaving them of children when he brought destruction against Jerusalem and her gates.
- And I shall winnow them with a fork in the gates of the land. I shall certainly bereave them of children. I will destroy my people, since they have not turned back from their own ways. (Jeremiah 15:7)
- The Ezekiel he promised to send both famine and wild beasts to bereave his people of their children for their unfaithfulness against him.
- And I will send upon you people famine and injurious wild beasts, and they must bereave you of children, and pestilence and blood themselves will pass along through you, and a sword I shall bring in upon you. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. (Ezekiel 5:17)
- And upon you I will cause humankind to walk, even my people Israel, and they must take possession of you, and you must become a hereditary possession to them, and you will not bereave them again of any more children. (Ezekiel 36:12)
- Therefore humankind you will no more devour, and your nations

you will no more bereave of children, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 36:14)

For although they bring up their sons, I will also bereave them of children so that there will be no man, because, woe also to them when I turn away from them! (Hosea 9:12)
