~BERED 2 (25) (Be'red) [Hail]

- A place in southern Palestine mentioned in the account of Hagar's fleeing from Sarai. The well of Beer-lahai-roi, at which Hagar stopped, lay in the wilderness between Bered and Kadesh, on the way to Shur.
- Later Yehowah's angel found her at a fountain of waters in the wilderness, at the fountain on the way to Shur. (Genesis 16:7)
- That is why the well was called Beerlahairoi. Here it is between Kadesh and Bered. (Genesis 16:14)
- The wilderness of Shur is a region Southwest of Philistia and on the way to Egypt, which may indicate that Hagar was heading back to her homeland.
- Later Moses caused Israel to depart from the Red Sea and they went out to the wilderness of Shur and marched on for three days in the wilderness, but they did not find water. (Exodus 15:22)
