

~BESIEGING (21)

[English, surrounding, laying siege to, sieving, overwhelming, encircling, blockading]

- All Israel was **besieging** Gibbethon.
- And Baasha the son of Ahijah of the house of Issachar began to conspire against him, and Baasha got to strike him down at Gibbethon, which belonged to the Philistines, while Nadab and all Israel were **besieging** Gibbethon. (1 Kings 15:27)
- In Samaria the **siege** was so bad that the head of an ass was worth eighty silver pieces, and a fourth of a cab of doves dung sold for five silver pieces.
- In time a great famine arose in Samaria, and, look! They were **besieging** it until an ass's head got to be worth eighty silver pieces, and the fourth of a cab measure of doves dung was worth five silver pieces. (2 Kings 6:25)
