~BETH-BIRI (28) (Beth-bir'i)

- A town in the Negeb region of Judah but assigned to the sons of Simeon.
- The sons of Simeon were Nemuel and Jamin, Jarib, Zerah, Shaul. (1 Chronicles 4:24)
- And in Beth-marcaboth and in Hazar-susim and in Beth-biri and in Shaaraim. These were their cities down till David reigned. (1 Chronicles 4:31)
- In the parallel list of towns at,
- And Beth-lebaoth and Sharuhen, thirteen cities and their settlements. (Joshua 19:6)
- It appears as Beth-lebaoth, and some suggest that Beth-biri may be a postexilic name for the same place, used by Ezra as the writer of the Chronicles. Evidence of the name may remain in that of Jebel el-Biri, a mountain about 40 kilometers (25 miles) Southwest of Beersheba. On this basis, some propose that Beth-biri was on or near this mountain.
